



After finishing runner-up in he 1982 Formula 1 Constructors World Championship, the Mc.Laren Team started the 1983 season with lesser chances to be so competitive as in the previous year. The biggest problem that the team had to face was the fact that they were still running the Ford Cosworth aspirated engine on the back of their Mc.Laren MP4/1C chassis, which was not so fast to match the turbo powered cars like Brabham, Ferrari and Renault. Even though, the team finished 5th. in the Constructors World Championship with 34 points. Watson finished 6th. in the Drivers World Championship with 22 points and Lauda 10th., with 12 points.

Besides being a transaction season for the team, as in the last 4 races they started using the TAG Porsche turbo engines (the debut was in the Dutch Grand Prix with Niki Lauda driving a Mc.Laren MP4/1E chassis), the team had a remarkable participation in the USA West Grand Prix at Long Beach, snatching a historic victory and second place with John Watson and Niki Lauda, after both drivers started from the 22nd and 23nd places respectively. It was the first time in Formula 1 History that a driver managed to win a race starting so far down on the grid, a record that persists until today.

Another landmark of the Mc.Laren MP4/1C chassis was the fact that it was tested by Ayrton Senna and Martin Brundle, following an invitation of Ron Dennis to the fastest Formula 3 drivers of 1983 (British Champion and runner-up). This was the first contact of Senna with the Mc.Laren team, predicting their so victorious future when Senna won 3 Drivers World Championships and the team dominated the end of the 80ies and beginning of the 90ies.

This kit enables you to build the 1983 USA West Grand Prix (Long Beach) winning version of John Watson. Besides it, we offer a complete decal sheet with additional options to build many other versions of the Mc.Laren MP4/1C as they were run during the 1983 season, the Ayrton Senna/Martin Brundle test versions and even the Mc.Laren MP4/1E TAG Porsche turbo engined car that ran in the last 4 races of the season (Holland, Italy, Europe and South Africa).
